



2005 Adams Vineyard Pinot Noir

Our Pinot Noir is a product of Adams Vineyard in the foothills of the Chehalem Mountains. It was designed to be fruit forward and has proven to be delightfully approachable. The nose has a typical Oregon “earthiness” of mushroom and forest floor that gives way to a velvety floral aroma.

This pinot is only 20% new oak but brings to it a wonderful smoky toast. On the palate you will definitely find bright fruit and cherry flavors.
